 Whereupon the said Mary Beirc is ordered to give Security for
 the payment of the severall Officers fees due by occasion of the
 premises aforesaid upon the Indictment aforesaid whereupon a certain Robert
 Auston of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper
 person Acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Lord
 Proprietary in the sum of five pounds Sterling of his body goods
 or Chattell Lands or tenements to be made and levied to the use
 of the Officers of Somerset County Court that hath any right to any
 fees upon the Indictment aforesaid &c.
 If it happen that the said Robert Auston do not pay and satisfy
 unto the severall Officers their fees due by occasion of the pre-
 :mises aforesaid upon the Indictment aforesaid &c.

 this Court did commit fornication with a certain person to the Jurors
 aforesaid unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and

 there a bastard Child on the body of her the said Mary to the high
 disgrace of Almighty God to the evil example of all others in
 such case offending contrary to the order of the s^d Lord Proprietary
 that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the
 act of a Assembly in such case lately made and provided &c.

 of Indictment it was thus Endorsed Viz^t. Billa Vera Dam^{us}. Wilson prem^{is}.
 Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County
 that he should take the said Mary Riggins if &c. to answer &c. And
 afterwards to wit the eighteenth day of November Anno Domini
