seven hundred and thirty five (and hereunto Court a certain John Hardy of Somerset County Gent. in his proper person and saith that he is willing to pay thirty Shillings current money of Maryland for the said Stephen Langcake for his fines by Occasion of the premises aforesaid.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid Stephen Langcake pay unto his Lordship the right honourable the Lord Proprietary for his fines by the Court hereupon <sup>him</sup> imposed for and by Occasion of the premises aforesaid whereof in form aforesaid he is convicted thirty Shillings current money of Maryland for the use of the County aforesaid and that the said Stephen Langcake be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fines aforesaid.

Whereupon the said Stephen Langcake is ordered to give Security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by Occasion of the premises aforesaid upon the Indictment aforesaid thereupon a certain John Hardy of Somerset County Gent. man present herein Court in his proper person acknowledged himself Indebted to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five pounds Sterling of his body goods or Chattells lands or tenements to be made and laid to the use of the Officers of Somerset County Court that hath any right to any fees upon the Indictment aforesaid.

If it happen that the said John Hardy do not pay and satisfy unto the severall Officers their fees due by Occasion of the premises aforesaid upon the Indictment aforesaid.

Likewise the said Stephen Langcake is ordered to give good Security to said aforesaid Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors for the time being from all Costs Charges Burthens and troubles that might accrue by means of the Birth of the Bastard Child lately begot on the body of the aforesaid Elizabeth Johnson &c.

Thereupon a certain George Lank of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Stephen Langcake and acknowledged himself Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of thirty pounds Sterling of his goods and Chattells lands and tenements ~~to be made~~ to be made and laid to the use of Somerset County if it happen that the aforesaid Stephen Langcake his heirs Executors and Administrators do and shall not from time to time and at all times for ever hereafter acquitt discharge and save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County from all Costs Charges and troubles whatsoever for or by reason of the Birth maintained nourishing and bringing up of
