Somerset County sh. The Jurors for the right honours  
liable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the Body of  
Somerset County aforesaid upon their Oath do present that  
George Sparkman late of Somerset Parish in the County aforesaid  
on the thirtieth day of October Anno Domini Seventeen hundred  
thirty and five at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the  
Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Henry Reynolds  
in the presence of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and  
there being with force and Arms an Assault did make and him  
the said Henry then and there did beat wound and evilly treat  
so that of his life it was greatly endangered and other harms to  
him then and there did to the Great damage of the said Henry  
and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is  
his good will and Government &c.

Test Henry Reynolds — On the backside of the foregoing Bill  
of Indictment it was thus endorsed viz. Billa Vera Sam. Wilson  
Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that  
he should take the said George Sparkman if he should be found and after  
wards to with the Eighteenth day of November Anno Domini One thousand  
Seven hundred and thirty five before the Justices of his Lordships County  
Court of Somerset now then held at dividing creek in the said County came  
the aforesaid George Sparkman in his proper person according to a certain  
recognizance by him and his Security before Acknowledged and had  
a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid who thereupon says that of the tres-  
passes and assault aforesaid as by the Indictment aforesaid aboves upon him  
imposed he is guilty thereof &c. — Whereupon all and singular  
the premises being seen and by the Court fully understood &c. It  
is considered that the aforesaid George Sparkman pay unto his Lordship  
the right honourable the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court  
imposed for and by Occasion of the ~~trespasses and assault~~ aforesaid  
Which in form aforesaid is Condemned Current Money of Maryland  
and that the said George Sparkman be taken to satisfy his said Lordship  
of the fine aforesaid Whereupon the said George Sparkman is ordered to  
give Security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by  
Occasion of the premises aforesaid Thereupon Robert Jenckins  
Henry of Somerset County Gent. present herein Court in his proper  
person undertook for the said George Sparkman for to pay the  
severall Officers fees due upon the Indictment and recognizance aforesaid  
by means of the premises aforesaid &c.
