that of his life it was greatly endangered and other harms to him then  
and there did to the great damage of the said William Boadley  
and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule  
and Government &c.

On the backside of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was Endorsed  
as followeth Viz: — Billa Vera Sam: Willson for max.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County  
that he should take the said William Caldwell if &c. to answer &c.  
and afterwards to wit the Eighteenth day of November Anno: Dom:  
One thousand seven hundred and thirty five before the Justices of  
his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at dividing  
Creek in and for the said County came the aforesaid William  
Caldwell in his proper person according to a certain recognizance  
by him and his Security before Acknowledged and had a hearing of  
the Indictment aforesaid who thereupon says that of the trespass and  
assault aforesaid he is guilty thereof.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here  
said heard and fully understood. It is considered that the aforesaid  
William Caldwell pay unto his Lordship the right honourable the  
Lord Proprietary for fine by the Court hereupon him imposed for  
and by occasion of the trespass and assault aforesaid whereof in form  
aforesaid he is convicted twenty Shillings current moneys of Maryland  
and the said William Caldwell be taken to satisfy this said Lordship  
of the fine aforesaid — and the several Officers their fees due upon the Indictment aforesaid

whereupon Joseph M. Tester Gent. high Sher. of Somerset County by James Anderson his deputy  
present took charge of the said Wm Caldwell accordingly &c.
