

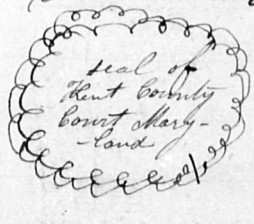

Filed and recorded December 4th 1849 and certificate of freedom issued as follows.
Maryland Kent County, to wit.

I, Joseph Redue, Clerk of Kent County Court, hereby certify to all whom it doth or may concern, that it hath been proved by testimony, which is satisfactory to me that the bearer hereof, a negro man, named Isaac Jones, aged about twenty one or twenty two years, five feet one and a quarter inches high, of a dark complexion, was born free, and raised in Kent County
