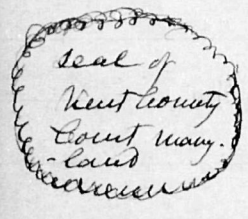

Maryland Kent County to wit:

Pursuant to the directions of an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at November Session Eighteen hundred and five, I hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern, that it has this day been proved by testimony satisfactory to me, that a certain Samuel Derry the bearer hereof was born of a free woman and that he was raised in said County, and brought up to farming, the said Negro is five feet six inches in height, between twenty one and twenty two years of age of light complexion and has a scar partly over the left eyebrow,
