Pursuant to the directions of an act of the general assembly of the State of Maryland, passed at November Session eighteen hundred and five, I hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern, that it has this day been proven, by testimony satisfactory to me that a certain Alexander Riley, the bearer hereof was born of a free woman, and that he was raised in the said County, and brought up to farming, the said Negro is five feet seven and one quarter inches in height, between twenty one and twenty two years of age, of a dark complexion, and has a scar on his left hand above the first joint of the thumb.
