from the cut of a scythe,

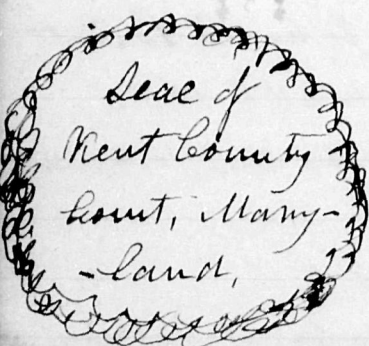
I Joseph Redue, Clerk of Kent County Court, hereby

born free, and raised in Kent County.
