 January eighteen hundred and fifty one, and is recorded
 in Liber I N G N. 4 pages 354 and 355 one of the record books
 of Kent County, said negro woman Francis Ann Perkins
 is about thirty five years old five feet three and three quarter
 inches high, is of a darkish complexion and has a scar on
 the right side of the face above the right corner of the mouth
 and also a scar on the left side of the neck
