


Extract from the last Will and Testament of George Washington Seth late of Queen Anns County deceased.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath to my Sister Mary Seth one Negro boy called Joe, one other called Bill & one called George. But my Will and desire is, that my Negroes herein before mentioned shall each and all have their freedom at the periods hereafter mentioned, to wit, my Negro boy Phill in the Year eighteen hundred and eighteen, Peter in the Year eighteen hundred thirty one, Henry in the Year eighteen hundred and twenty five, Joe in the Year eighteen hundred and twenty, Bill in the Year eighteen hundred twenty two and George in the Year eighteen hundred twenty eight.
