Whereas application has been made to me by a certain Negro woman named Susan or Suckey, who calls herself Susan Anderson, for a certificate of freedom under an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at November Session 1805. I do therefore certify to all persons whom it dath or may concern, that by the last Will & Testament of a certain Mr Hensley, duly executed on the 7th day of May 1821 and his Codicil thereto, executed on the 5th day of April 1823, the last of which was proved in my Office on the 19th and the first on the 25th day of Nov 1825 — A certain Negro Woman named Susan a Suckey, five feet three inches in height, about thirty five years of age, dark complexion, a small scar on the fore finger of her left hand, occasioned by a cut, a dark spot on the left side of her face about the size of a dollar, which she states was occasioned by the application of a mustard plaster, and tolerable good teeth — was manumitted and set free — Her freedom to take place at the end of two years from the decease of the said Mr Hensley — Her person was identified by a certain Egbert F Chambers, who is the Adm with the will annexed of the deceased given under my hand and the seal of my Office
