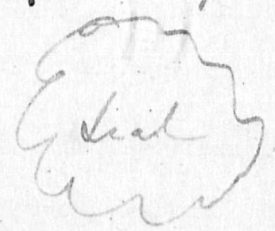

Her freedom to commence after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January after the Testatrix's decease. Her person I identify by the Oath of a certain Mary Biscoe - Given under my hand and the seal of my Office this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April

I hereby certify, that a certain Negro Man named Sam, who calls himself Sam Willon, about 30 years of age, very dark complexion, five feet five & a fourth inches in height, a dark spot on the upper part of his left wrist on or near the joint, a long scar on his right leg, good countenance & pretty good teeth, was manumitted and set free by the last will & Testaments of Nathan Baynard duly executed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1828 and proved in my Office on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1829. His freedom to commence at the decease of the Testator. His person I identify by the Oath of a certain James Roe - Given

under my hand & the seal of my Office this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 1829
