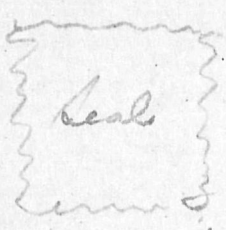

I hereby certify, that a certain Negro woman named Harriette, about 30 years of age, dark complexion, four feet ten inches in height, delicate form, good countenance and has lost a part of the fore finger of her left hand, was manumitted and set free by the last Will & Testament of a certain Mary Devonish, duly executed on the ___ day of June and proved in my Office on the 25th day of June 1819

Her freedom to commence on the 3rd day of June 1826. Her person identified by the Oath of a certain Col. Deornith

I hereby certify, that a certain dark mulatto woman named Jude, who calls herself Jude Smith, supposed to be about thirty years of age, five feet and three quarters of an inch in height, a small round scar on her left shoulder, and a scar on the fore finger of her left hand between the first and second joints, was manumitted and set free by the last Will and Testament of a certain Margaret Kingjolly, duly executed on the 6th day of May and proved in my Office on the 30th day of Oct 1819.

She was stated to be about twenty years old at the time the Will was executed, and to have her freedom at the age of thirty years. Her person was identified by the Oath of a certain Thos. L. Downes - Given under my hand
