I hereby certify, that a certain negro woman named Lucy, who calls herself Lucy Walton now about thirty years of age, light complexion, a scar on her right cheek bone about an inch from the corner of her right eye, also a scar on the upper part and right side of her breast bone, good countenance, five feet two & three quarter inches in height - was manumitted and set free by the last will and Testaments of a certain John Browne of Mathans, duly executed on the 12th and proved in my office on the 23^d day of December 1815 - Her freedom to commence in twelve years from the first day of January 1816 - Her person identified by the Oath of a certain Thomas C. Browne, one of the heirs of the said John Browne, died - Given under my hand and the seal of my office this 16 day of November Anno Domini 1830
