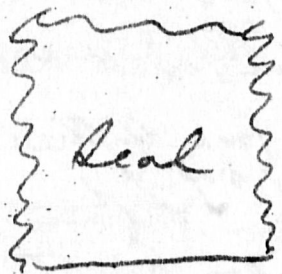

I hereby certify, that a Mulatto woman named Selina, now about twenty four years of age, five feet two and a half inches in height, slender delicate form, a mole on her right arm near the elbow joint, a very small scar near the centre of her right eye brow & a mole on the inside of her right hand on the thick part of her thumb, was manumitted and set free by the following clause in the will of the late Wm. Telferman, dec'd, duly executed on the 12th day of September Eighteen hundred and nine and proved in my office on the 13th day of November Eighteen hundred and ten, that is to say "I hereby give liberty to, and manumit, and at freedom to, my woman named Selina and all her children and a boy named Bob. The said woman Selina is known to the Register. Given under my hand and the seal of my Office this 8th day of May Eighteen hundred and thirty two.
