I hereby certify, that a certain negro woman named Hannah, now about thirty five years of age, five feet one inch & a half in height, her complexion on the yellowish order, her person rather delicate, has a large scar on her left Arm between the wrist and elbow & another small scar on the same Arm just above the elbow, was manumitted and set free by the last will and Testament of a certain Daniel Weedon, duly executed on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Oct and proved on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1797, by that clause of his will which disposes of the residue of his estate. Her freedom to commence when she shall have attained the age of thirty five years. Her person was identified by the Oaths of a certain Elizabeth Sness & Henry Weedon; also by the certificate of one John Weedon. — Given under my hand and
