last Will & Testament of a certain Wm. Mackitt, duly  
executed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 1807 and proved  
in my office on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1808. Her freedom  
to commence on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of Dec 1825 — Her
