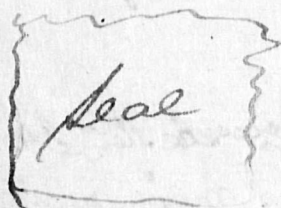

 on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 1812, Her freedom to commence  
 when she shall have attained the age of thirty years
