I hereby certify, that a certain Negro woman named Frances, who calls herself 'Frances Roberts,' not about thirty seven years of age, black complexion and well made, has a scar on her right arm above her elbow, occasioned by the small pox, and is five feet four and a half inches in height, - was manumitted and set free by the Last Will and Testament of Elijah Lomegys, duly executed on the 29 day of July 1805, and proved in my Office on the 22 day of June 1811. - at the Execution of the aforesaid Will, the said Frances was said to be eleven years old in January last, and to be free at the age of thirty years, her person was identified by the Oath of Benjamin Lomegys who was a Nephew and Legatee of the Testator above mentioned

I hereby certify, that a Negro woman Sarah who calls herself Sarah - now about 40 years of age five feet two & a quarter inches in height Complexion black - several small scars on each of her arms above the Elbow, was manumitted and set free by the last Will and Testament of a certain Joshua Perkins, duly executed on the 1 day of April 1827, and proved in my Office on the 15 day of September 1827. - her freedom to commence from and after the expiration of 6 years from his decease, and her person having been identified by the oath of a certain William Bryan
