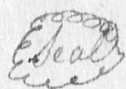

I hereby certify that a certain negro woman named Eliza aged about forty years has a large scar on her left shoulder occasioned from a burn, several scars on hands and wrists, stout build, prominent features, a large mouth, and of a brown colour, is 5 ft. 4 1/2 inches in height and was manumitted & set free by the last will & testament of a certain Benjamin Higgins duly executed on the 17. Decr. 1823. and proved in my office on the 20 July 1825. her freedom to commence on 10th Jan'y 1834. and her person having been identified by the oath of a certain Jas. J. Clark.



In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed the seal of my office this day of 1835,

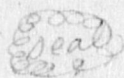

Whereas application has been made to me by a certain negro woman named Selvey alias Selvey Dodd for a certificate of freedom under the Act of the General Assembly passed at Nov. session 1805.

I do therefore hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern that by the last will & testament of a certain Hester M^cbosh duly executed on the 19th day of June in the year 1813. a certain negro woman named Selvey, 5 ft. 3/4 of an inch in height, light coloured and flesh marked was left free by the aforesaid Hester M^cbosh when the said Selvey shall have attained to the age of thirty. She having identified by a certain John Bigby
