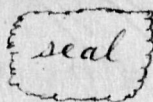


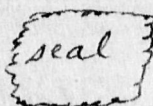

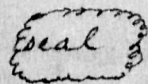
Thereby certify that a certain Negro man by the name of Madison, or otherwise Madison Garnett aged about 28 years five feet 8 1/2 inches high, and is very Black, has no scars, was manumitted and set free by the Last Will and Testament of a certain Philip Feddeman, duly executed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 and admitted to probate on the 22<sup>nd</sup> Janry 1822 his freedom to commence on the first of Janry 1837, and his person being identified by the Oath of a certain Rich<sup>d</sup> J. Earle.

Thereby certify that a certain Negro Woman by the name of Deala Baxter, otherwise called Deala age about 36 years, five feet 1 1/2 inches high, and is very Black, has some scars on her right arm was manumitted and set free by the last will and Testament of a certain Vinson Baxter, duly executed on the 13<sup>th</sup> July 1831, and admitted to probate on the 5<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1831, her freedom being identified by the Oath of a certain, Ann Philips.
