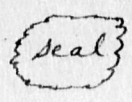

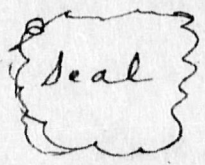

I hereby certify that by the last Will and Testament of a certain James Duhamel, late of Queen Anns County Dec^d, duly executed on the twentieth day of August eighteen hundred and sixteen and admitted to Probate on the twenty ninth day of September Eighteen hundred and seventeen, a certain Mulatto man named Phill now about forty two or three years of age, a bright Mulatto five feet in height, having a remarkable scar on his Breast bone, was manumitted and set free by the said Testator when he shall have arrived at the age of thirty five years, the said Mulatto man Phill was identified and his age proved by a certain James Stant of said County.

State of Maryland Queen Anns County to wit.

I hereby certify that by the last Will & Testament of a certain Mary Barnes, late of Queen Anns County, dec^d, duly executed on the 1st day of June 1797 and admitted to probate in the 13th day of June 1838 a certain Negro girl named Jill and her issue both male and female to the remotest generation were manumitted and set free when she and the said issue shall severally arrive at the age of twenty five years; now a certain Mulatto man named Ann, otherwise called Ann Reese, about thirty two or three years of age, a bright Mulatto 4 feet 1/4 Inches high, was identified
