I certify that a certain negro Woman, named Charlotte aged about thirty one years, of a Mulatto Colour five feet one Inch high, - has no particular Marks, - was set free by the last Will and Testament of a certain Benjamin Roe, duly executed on the 26 March 1829, - and admitted to Probate in my office on the 25 May 1829. - her freedom to commence on the 19 Sep: 1838 - and her person being identified by the evidence of a certain Berj Roe.
