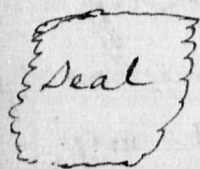

I certify that a certain negro woman named Priscilla, aged about thirty three years, and is five feet one inch and a quarter high, - of a light Copper color, and has no particular marks, - was manumitted and set free by the last Will and Testament of Mrs Catharine Bruff, late of Queen Anns County dec<sup>d</sup> duly executed in the month of August 1829, and admitted to probat in my office on the 3 April 1822, - and her freedom to commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1823 - her person being identified by the evidence of Henry E Wright
