


I do hereby certify that a certain Negro woman Hannah, aged about 45 Years, five feet three Inches high, dark complexion, has a scar on her right Arm from a burn and a scar on the 3^d finger of her right hand, was manumitted and set free by the last will and Testament of a certain Philip Dredman dated July the 8th 1821 and admitted to probat in my Office on the 22^d day of January 1822. the said Negro to be free at the age of twenty eight years her person identified by the evidence of a certain Richard S. Carle

I Do hereby certify that a certain Negro man named Jacob Williams aged about 40 years, five feet six inches high, dark complexion, has a scar on his left cheek below the corner of his eye, was manumitted and set free by last will and Testament of John Heets dated 6th day of June 1837 and admitted to probate 27th February 1838 freedom to commence at the age of 35 years his person identified by the evidence of James Callahan.
