I hereby Certify that a certain Negro man named Jacob Arthur Heath, now about twenty five years old light complexion five feet eight & a quarter inches high and has a scar on his forehead & a larger one on his breast was manumitted & set free by the last will and testament of a certain Jesse Heath dated 14th Aug. 1831 and admitted to probate in my office on the 26th day of February of the same year his freedom to commence when the debts of the said Jesse Heath are satisfied which has been done according to the evidence of Roderick Eargle son Adm^r of Heath's Decentor, his person identified by the evidence of John C. Tolson.
