




Bryan

I hereby certify that a certain negro woman named Rachel, now about thirty years old, five feet one inch high of tolerable dark complexion & has no scars or mark at this time, was manumitted & set free by the last will and Testament of a certain Margaret Chambers dated on the 2nd August 1824 & admitted to probat in my office on the 28th November 1838. her freedom to commence at the age of twenty five years - and her person identified by the evidence of a certain Richard Carter,
