


I hereby certify that a certain negro man named Dennis now about thirty five Years old of light complexion five feet six inches in height & has a scar on his forehead was manumitted and set free by the last will and Testament of a certain Elizabeth Maxwell dated on the 14th day of January 1831 and admitted to probat on the 19th February 1831 (in my office) his freedom to Commence on the 1st day of January 1836 his person Identified by the Testimony of a certain Charles Reed together with the letter of Wm Reed. ^{Interimary Act: 17. 1845}
