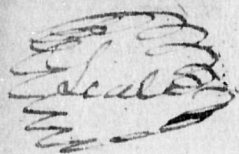


Maryland Queen Anns County to wit

Her freedom to Commence on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December 1845. Her person identified by the evidence of a certain Jonathan Crane.

Her freedom to Commence at the age of thirty five years. Her person identified by the evidence of a certain Peter Foster.
