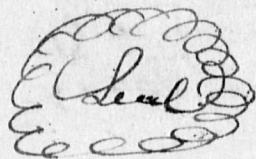

His freedom to commence on the death of the testator's wife who died in the year 1843: his person identified by the evidence of a certain Samuel Bryan.

I hereby certify that a certain negro woman named Margaret now about thirty nine years old five feet four & a quarter inches in height of dark complexion & has a scar on the right side of her neck was manumitted & set free by the last will & testament of a certain Sam^l W Thomas dated on the thirteenth August 1829 & admitted to probate on the 26th day of the same month. Her freedom to commence at the age of thirty five years. Her person I identified by the evidence of a certain Miss Sarah Tucker.
