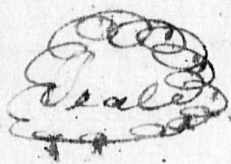


State of Maryland Queen Anns County to wit

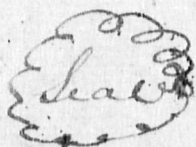
