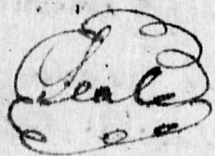

I hereby certify that a certain negro man named Jacob now about thirty five years old five feet ten & a quarter inches high, ^{not black but dark} of light complexion & has a ^{small} scar on his upper lip was manumitted and set free by the last will and testament of a certain William Bryan dated 30th August 1830 and admitted to probate in my office the 12th March 1831 his freedom to commence when he is thirty years of age, his person identified by the evidence of a certain Robert S. Bryan.
