I hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern that a certain negro man named ^{John} now about thirty years of age, five feet six inches high of dark complexion & has a scar on his forehead & also on his left leg, was manumitted & set free by the last will and testament of a certain Philemon Thomas dated on the 28th November 1831 and admitted to probate in my office on the 19th day of December 1831 - his freedom to commence on the first day of January eighteen hundred and forty eight, his person identified by the evidence of a certain John Tilghman Esquire.

Maryland Queen Anne's County, I hereby certify that a certain negro man named Tom (ain) now about 28 years old, five feet, eight inches high of light complexion & has a scar on his left knee and one on his right thumb was manumitted & freedom appears by the last will & testament of Philip Fiddeman dated January 22nd 1822 & admitted to probate in my office in the year 1822 & admitted his freedom to commence 1st day of January 1858 according to the inventory of said Philip Fiddeman on the day 1822 his person identified by the evidence of a certain G. A. T. Wright -
