of age hath a burn on the left Shoulder, was manumitted
and set free her freedom to commence at the
death of the said Charles Hertland, and proved by
the oath of a certain Thomas Wooters to be the identical
person as mentioned in said Will, In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed the pub-
lic seal of my office this 1st day of April 1815

ish complexion five feet nine and a fourth inches high
about thirty four years of age hath a very remarkable
scar on the bone of the left Cheek, just below the eye, and
another on the right Cheek, was manumitted and set
free his freedom to commence on the expiration of Ten
Years from the date thereof
