 concern that by the last will and Testament of a certain
 Sarah Williston late of Queen Anne's County deceased duly
 executed on the thirteenth day of March seventeen hundred
 and ninety five, and proved in my office on the 1st
 day of April in the same year a certain negro boy
 named Tom of a dark complexion five feet six and a 1/4
 inch high about twenty nine years old hath a scar over
 the right eye occasioned by a hurt a remarkable wart
 on the left ear, and a scar on the left hand near the joint
 of the fore finger. Was manumitted and set free
 his freedom to commence in the year 1811 and proved
 by the Oath of Major Thomas Emory to be the essenti-
 cal person mentioned in the said Will,
