 Concern that by the last will and Testament
 of a certain Thomas Elliott late of Queen Anne's
 County deceased duly executed on the 2^d day of
 November 1813 and produced in my Office on
 the 24th day of May 1814 a certain Negro Wo-
 man named Lucy of a dark complexion
 five feet ten and 1/2 inches high about
 thirty five years of age had a scar on the
 right side of the neck several scars on the
 right arm and several on the right and
 left knee above and below the knee was
 manumitted and set free her freedom
