a Certain Jonathan Roberts duly executed on the
12th day of November 1796 and proved in my office
on the 27th day of July 1797 a certain Negroe.

Boy named Davis of a Dark complexion five
feet three and a half Inches high now about Twenty
Two years of age, hath a Wart on the Back part
of the left ear, and scars apparently natural
on the left right arm was in an untried and
set free his Freedom to commence on the
Christmas day next ensuing the death of the
Testator, his person identified by the calls of
two respectable citizens of this County.

Maryland Queen Anne's County, I do hereby
Certify that by the last Will and Testament of
a Certain Benjamin Rigby late of Queen Anne's
County deceased duly executed on the 29th January
1803 and proved in my office on the 30th May 1815
a Certain Negro Woman named Darkij of a
dark complexion five feet and one Inch high
about Forty five years of age hath a flesh mark
on the Cheek bone near the left eye was man-
-untried and I freed her freedom to com-
-mence at the death of the Testator her
