 October, seventeen hundred and ninety four, and  
 proved in my Office, on the sixteenth day of  
 December, in the same year, a certain negro  
 Boy named Harry, of a dark complexion

 five feet nine inches high, and who hath a  
 scar in the joint of the forefinger, on the right  
 hand, and small scar on the breast, a high fore  
 head and well made, was manumitted and  
 set free his freedom to commence on the twenty  
 fifth day of December, in the year of our Lord  
 Eighteen hundred and Ten, and who is well  
 known by the subscriber, to be the identical person
