Whereas application has been made to me by a
certain negro ^{Man} named ~~Phode~~ ^{Phode} for a certificate of
his freedom under an act of the General Assembly
of this State - This is therefore to certify to all whom
it doth concern that by the last Will and
Testament of a certain Isaac Jump late of
Queen Anne's County deceased duly executed on
the 17th day of May 1802 and proved in my office
on the 18th day of June in the same year a certain
Negro Woman named Phode of a yellowish
Complexion five feet one inch and seven eighths of an
inch high about thirty eight years of age. She
hath a scar on the left arm above the elbow occasioned
by the inoculation of the small pox, is tolerably well
made, Was unannulled and set free her freedom
to commence at the Expiration of ten years from the
death of the Testator, her person Verified by the oath
of a certain Elizabeth Abbott

November session Eighteen hundred and five, and Whereas
it appears to me by Record in my office that the said Negro
Man Harry did heretofore Court on the fourth day of June
eighteen hundred and twelve obtain from the then
Register of Wills for Queen Anne's County such Certificate
and again on the fourth day of May Eighteen hundred
and fourteen it appears by the authority aforesaid that
a second Certificate was granted to the said Negro Man
Harry by reason of satisfactory proof of his losing the
