duly executed on the 17th day of February eighteen
hundred and Ten and proved in my office on the 30th
day of April 1811 a Certain Negro Woman named
Henrietta of a dark complexion about ^{twenty} years
of age five feet three and a half inches high
very well made of full face and has a black
mole between her nose and upper lip and another
between her under lip and Chin she says that
she has had her ears pierced, and where the
flesh has grown out something like that of
Wants - Was Manumitted and set
free her freedom to commence after her serving
six years and six months from the first day
of January Eighteen hundred and Ten which
happened on the first day of July last past
her person identified by the oath of a Certain
Samuel Smith Esq Sept 16 - 1810.

Whereas application hath been made to me by a
