The State of Maryland Queen Anns County Court  
 Whereas application hath been made to me by a  
 Certain Negro Man named Moses for a Certificate of his free  
 -dom, I do therefore in pursuance of an act of the General assembly  
 of this State passed at November session Eighteen hundred  
 and five, hereby certify that by the last Will and Testament  
 of a Certain Richard Hall duly Executed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of  
 April 1809. and proved in my Office on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June  
 1809. A Certain Negro Boy named Moses of a dark complexion  
 about Twenty five years of age five feet three inches and three  
 fourths of an inch high, has a scar under the right eye, and  
 the third finger on the right hand crippled in the third joint  
 and is crooked, was manumitted and set free his free dom to Com-  
 -mence after serving seven years from the Execution of said Will  
 his person Identified by the oath of a Certain James B  
 Williams - October 8<sup>th</sup> 1810. Tho C. Carlo Rog Mills
