Man named Phill for a Certificate of his freedom under an
act of the General assembly of the State of Maryland passed
November the first Eighteen hundred and five, I do therefore
hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern
that by the last Will and Testament of a Certain William
Stevens late of Queen Anns County deceased duly executed on the
fourth day of April 1813 and proved in my office on the 25th
of September in the same year a Certain Negro Man named
Phill of a dark complexion about thirty and years of age
five feet seven inches and $\frac{7}{8}$ high, hath well made halt
a scar on the left side of the upper lip occasioned by a cut
was manumitted and got free his freedom to commence
after he having served four years from the first day of
January next ensuing after the death of the deceased. his
person identified by James Bewley. In Testimony &c.
this second day of Jan 1818

of this State passed November the first Eighteen hundred and five. I do
therefore hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern that
by the last Will and Testament of a Certain James Warrister late of
Queen Anns County deceased duly executed on the third day of April 1813
and proved in my office on the 8th day of the same month in the year
afore said, a Certain Negro Man named Nathan, about twenty six years
of age five feet one inch & three eighths of an inch high, of a dark
well made of a dark complexion, hath a scar on the right arm
near the Elbow, occasioned by a Burn, no other visible marks,
was manumitted and got free his freedom to commence at the end of
