 Whereas a certain negro man named Lee has made an ap-
 plication to me for a certificate of his freedom under an act
 of the General Assembly of this State passed November Ses-
 sion Eighteen hundred and five; I do therefore hereby certify
 to all persons whom it doth or may concern that by the
 last will and Testament of certain William Biggs late
 of Queen Anns County deceased duly executed on the 28th
 day of March 1805 and proved in my office on the 10th
 day of April 1805. a certain Negro man named Lee
 of a dark complexion five feet six and a half high
 hath a scar on the fore finger of the right hand extending
 from the jointure of the hand to the finger thence running
 down to the end of the joint of the same finger. Was then
 manumitted and set free to his freedom to come and re-
 maining at 30 years of age his person identified by
 certain John W. Wilson. Given under my hand
 the 7th of March 1818
