The State of Maryland Queen Anns County 1818. Whereas
application has this day been made to me by a certain
Negro Woman named Tommy for a Certificate of her being a
free person. I do therefore hereby certify to all persons
whom it doth or may concern that by the last Will and Tes-
tament of a certain James Kent late of Queen Anns County
deceased duly executed on the 29th day of May 1802 and
proved in my Office on the 14th day of August 1805
a certain Negro Woman named Tommy of a yellowish
Complexion about thirty eight years of age five feet one
Inch high, half a year on the right Arm below
the Elbow occasioned by a burn her teeth much dis-
eas'd and set was manumitted and set free her freedom
to commence on the 21st day of December first after the death
of the Testator her person Identified by a certain James
Kent - Given under my hand this 17th day of May 1818
