

Certain Edward Beck late of Queen Army family deceased
 duly executed on the 17th day of August 1816 and proved
 in my office on the 23^d day of November 1816 a certain
 Negro Man named "Moses" of a Dark complexion
 about forty three years of age, a little grey headed - has
 a scar on the left rib to five feet three inches and three
 fourths of an inch high Was manumitted and set free
 his freedom to commence on the Christmas day following
 the death of the testator - his person identified by
 the oath of a certain John Brown

In Testimony & this 3rd day of August 1818

Whereas Negro Adam has this day been made to me
 by a certain Negro Man named Adam for a certificate of his
 freedom; I do therefore hereby certify to all persons whom it shall
 or may concern that by the last Will and Testament of a
 certain Jacob Huron late of Queen Army family deceased
 duly executed on the preceding office on the 15 day of
 December 1810 a certain Negro Man named Adam
 of a Yellowish complexion, stout make five feet 3/4
 inches high about twenty four years of age since a scar
 on the calf of the left leg Was manumitted and set
 free his freedom to commence after his ^{labour} having been worth
 one hundred pounds to the testator's estate a Release
 from his ^{the testator's} devices being now before his person identified
 by the oath of a certain Richard Hattis
