of her freedom, This is therefore to certify to all persons whom
it doth or may concern that by the last Will and Testament
of a Certain Elizabeth Harris late of Queen Anne's County deceased
duly executed on the seventh day of April 1814 and proved in
my office on the tenth day of May of the same year a certain
Negro Woman named Maria of a yellowish complexion
about thirty two years of age five feet three and half inches
high, has two scars occasioned by Burns one above and the
other below the Elbow. Was manumitted & set free her
freedom to commence at the death of the Testator. Her
person Identified by a certain Henry Melmer of the

named Perry for a Certificate of his being a free person. This is
therefore to certify that to all persons whom it doth or may concern
that by the last Will and Testament of a Certain Thomas Carter
late of Queen Anne's County deceased proved and of Record in my
office bearing date the 20. day of August 1805 a Certain Negro
Boy named Perry, who is now about thirty one years old of a
dark yellowish complexion, stand made five feet deep inches and
and half inches high has a scar on the her eye brows and
one on the right ankle occasioned by a fall, Was manumitted
and set free his freedom to commence at the age of twenty
seven years - his person identified by a certain
James Kepting of said County
