Whereas a certain Negro Man named Fency has this day made application to me for letters Certificate of his being left free by the last Will and Testament of John Doornick late of Queen Anns County deceased - I do therefore hereby certify to all persons whom it doth or may concern that by the last Will & Testament of a certain John Doornick late of Queen Anns County deceased proved in my office on the seventeenth day of September Eighteen hundred and Eleven, a certain Negro Man named Fency of a dark complexion about forty years of age four feet ten in inches high a fair set of teeth the right arm none other visible, Was manumitted and set free her freedom to commence at the expiration of three years from the death of the testator her person identified by Captain Horatio Jennings.
