of late of Quinn's Senior County dec<sup>d</sup> duly Executed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day  
of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1787 and legally proved in my office on the 21<sup>st</sup> day  
of the same month (Dec<sup>r</sup>) and in the same year a certain  
negro man named Joe who is the bearer hereof of a middling  
dark complexion five feet eight inches high a broad flat  
nose, has a scar on his third and fourth finger of his left hand  
and a flesh mole on his breast, and is about thirty nine years  
of age; was manumitted and set free; his freedom to com-  
-mence - at the Expiration of the year of our Lord eight hundred  
and eight - and proved by the oaths of W<sup>m</sup> Tucker  
and Sam<sup>l</sup> Bungey Esquires to be the identical person as men-  
-tioned by the Testator in his said will
