 and testament of a certain John W. Hittinger late of Queen Anne's County deceased proved
 in my office on the 11th of August fourteen hundred and twenty four a certain
 negro man named Peter dark complexion five feet nine inches and a half in
 men high has a scar on the second joint of the left thumb occasioned by a cut upon an
 O. the upper the left eyebrow no other visible the said Peter was his freedom to commence
 after the age of twenty five years his words of twenty four years of age this
 4th of October 1819 his person identified by a certain Robert Taylor of Queen Anne's
 County

 last will and testament of a certain George D. Drown late of Queen Anne's County
 deceased proved in my office on the 19th of March 1805
 a certain negro man named Peter dark complexion five feet four and a
 half inches in height has two scars on the back part of his head
 occasioned by a cut having been but no other visible aged 23 years was set
 free his freedom to commence after a servitude of fifteen years his
 person identified by a certain Valentine Young of Queen Anne's County

 1820

 that by the last will and testament of a certain Pizzella Wilmer late
 of Queen Anne's County deceased and executed on the twenty third
 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and thirteen and proved in my office on the twenty eighth day of
 March eighteen hundred and fourteen after mentioned by name a
 number of negroes making the following disposition the negroes
 that I sold to Philip Thennard of Kent County I will to be
 free at the expiration of the respective time of years for which
 they are sold and whereas the said Philip Thennard has forwarded
 to me a certificate certifying that a certain negro woman named
 Kate & sold has served the time for which she was sold to
 him and the said negro Kate having made application
