(Whereas a certain negro Man named
Samuel, has made application to me for a certificate
of freedom, under the act of the General Assembly of
Maryland, passed at November Session, Eighteen
hundred and five. I do therefore certify to all whom
it doth or may concern, that by the last-will & Testament
of a certain William Legg, late of Queen Anns County
deceased, duly executed on the 9th day of April 1814
and proved in my Office on the 9th day of December
1815 - a certain negro Boy named Samuel of a very
light-complexion, five feet-eight inches in height
thick set, round face and fine black hair, was
manumitted & set free by the last-will & Testament
of the said William Legg - his freedom to commence
on the first-day of January 1821. His person identi-
fied by a certain William Harper Swr. Given
under my hand & Seal this 20th day of August
in the year of our Lord, Eighteen hundred and
twenty two.
